

Waiting List Policy

When we receive your deposit, we will add you to our waiting list for the litter in general, but we do not allow anyone to pick out a specific puppy until the litter is about 6 weeks old. When the litter is 6 weeks old, each person will be able to choose a puppy according to his/her order on the waiting list. Please read below our reasons for this policy:

1. We are not able to determine the personality of the puppy until it is about 4-5 weeks old. All of the puppies are well socialized, but there are still differences in energy levels and personality.
2. It is difficult to truly see coloring and waviness of coat until the puppies are about 4 weeks old.
3. If someone lives close enough and would like to see the puppies before picking one out, we do not allow visitors until the puppies are 6 weeks old.
4. We do not know if the puppy will have a tendency to be a light shedder or not until he/she is about 6 weeks old. While Cockapoos do not shed much, some can be light shedders. While the shedding is not very noticeable and will probably not matter with a pet, breeding stock must be very carefully selected.
5. When we, as breeders, choose to consider a puppy for a future addition to our breeding stock, we need to give careful consideration to the qualities mentioned above, as well as others, so that we can be sure to keep a puppy that has the right genetics for breeding future generations.
